





MARC Magician Professional has several features to assist with cataloging, including a robust Help section and the Auto Error Checking function.

This overview gives a basic outline of these features and how to use them.



Help Features

From the Main Window, access Help using either the Help Menu or the

Help button from the navigation bar.




You can also use F1 on your keyboard.



The Help Menu

Go to the File menu.





Help Topics takes you online to www.mitinet.com.

When you first install MARC Magician, you may receive an error message when you try to access the Help Menu.

This happens because Microsoft does not support the WinHlp32.exe help program in the newer versions of Windows.

Go to the FAQ on Failure to Install Help to find instructions for installing a work around that will allow you access to the Help Topics.



For each Help Topic, there are instructions and examples. Please note that these are also visible right on screen as you work in Cataloger.



You don't have to leave Cataloger to access the Help features.







Auto Error Checking

To set up Auto Error Checking.

Use Active Error Checking options to define which issues you want to be notified about and which issues you want to ignore. Click the Options button on the toolbar and select Active Error Checking.

There are three levels of error checking: Basic, Texas Library Connection, and Custom.





The Active Error Checking Settings dialog box shows everything MARC Magician can flag.


For most issues, choose one of three options: export error, warning, or ignore. There are no notifications for issues set to ignore. Warnings and export errors are distinguished in various ways in the main window, the Cataloger, and the Record Viewer.

Notice that some issues are always export errors. These are serious problems that should always be corrected. How you set the other issues is up to you.




Active Error Window in Cataloger

If you don't see the Active Error Checking panel, it may be turned off. Turn it on by opening the View menu and clicking Active Error Checking Panel.



Possible errors are shown in the Active Error Checking box as you catalog.








Active Error Window in the Main Window


On a list the Active Error Checking indicators shows up as color signals in the first column of the list.

Records with no errors will have a green "OK".



Records with export errors will have a red circle.



Records with warnings will have a yellow triangle.

To see what the specific error is for any record, click on the record to open it in Record Viewer and look at the comments in the Active Error Checking box in the lower right corner.



Important

Active Error Checking is very helpful, but it isn't foolproof.

Records showing an OK may have other problems that MARC Magician won't flag, and records that show export errors or warnings may actually be correct.

For example...

If you have Active Error Checking set to flag a missing publication date, serials (which usually don't have this subfield) will show errors or warnings even though they are actually correct.

Best practice is to check each record for errors as it's created, review global edits carefully, and use Spell Check.
