






MARC Magician Professional 2011™ is a powerful cataloging program, with customizable templates, global editing tools, active error checking and other features to make creating and editing MARC records easy.

This tutorial reviews MARC Magician Pro's features and gives you a broad idea of what you can do with this easy to use cataloging program.



When you open MARC Magician, you'll be in the Main Window. The Main Window is always open. When you close it, you close the program.




Records in MARC Magician are managed with lists, displayed in a spreadsheet format, with each row an individual record. Like other spreadsheets, you can rearrange columns, make them wider or narrower or hide them completely.




Program Overview

Many buttons on the Navigation bar are things you already use in other programs, like Print, Cut, Copy, Paste and Undo. We'll review the features of the MARC Magician specific buttons in detail but here is a brief description.









MARC Magician Pro Lists

In MARC Magician Pro MARC records are managed with lists.
The Master List contains all the records either imported into
or created in the MARC Magician database.

List name is identified here




The open list name is also identified at the bottom of the screen as well as the sorting method, and number of records.




MARC Magician Pro Lists

The Weeding Truck is like the Recycle Bin. Deleted records or lists go to the Weeding Truck. When you empty the Weeding Truck, you've deleted those records.




When the Weeding Truck is minimized, it shows as a tab at the bottom of the Main Window.





Record Viewer

In Record Viewer, quickly page from one record to the next, and maintain an unlimited number of open records. To open, select the records you want to view in the Master List, and then click the Record Viewer button on the toolbar.






Cataloger

Use Cataloger to create and edit MARC records. To open Cataloger, double click on a record in the Master List or click the Edit button in the lower right corner of Record Viewer.

The open record displays in a separate window inside Cataloger.




Cataloger allows a maximum of 10 open pages at a time. To look at the details for more than 10 records at once, use Record Viewer.



Cataloger

Several cataloging aids are built-in to the Cataloger screen. To begin cataloging new records or editing existing ones, put your cursor in a field. Menu driven field and sub-field options and field specific information panels help you enter accurate record data for that field.

Close Cataloger to return to the Main Window.




Help Sections

Thorough and up-to-date information about how to use MARC Magician Professional, displayed directly on your computer screen.


These sections have complete instructions for working with the program as well as general cataloging advice and detailed explanations of MARC fields and subfields.





General help topics: Including overviews, step-by-step instructions, & a glossary of technical and cataloging terms. To get to general help topics, click the Help button on the toolbar, or press the F1 key on your keyboard.

Dialog box help: Most dialog boxes have a Help button in the lower right corner. With the dialog box open, click the Help button or press the F1 key for an explanation on how to use that dialog box.



Cataloger's Reference: Gives general cataloging advice and details about most MARC fields, including examples and information about subfields and indicators. To open the Cataloger's Reference topic for a specific field, click the tag of that field and then click the Help button.
